



# Stony Brook East Hampton Emergency Department Is Now Open

The much-anticipated Stony Brook East Hampton Emergency Department is open as of Thursday, May 22.

The 22,000-square-foot facility will serve as an emergency room for those in East Hampton Town, including Amagansett, Montauk, Sag Harbor and Springs. The idea behind the project – which was funded through private donations and a \$10 million dollar state grant – is to provide care for those on the “farthest end” of the South Fork, the hospital said in a release.

The new emergency department – which is one of the only free-standing departments in the state – will be open 365 days per year. Next to the emergency department is a non-emergency imaging center which is open from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Monday through Friday.

In the new facility, there will be a dedicated resuscitation room, exam rooms with cardiac monitoring equipment, fast-track treatment rooms, two isolation rooms and an onsite ambulance. Aside from the equipment, the emergency department is equipped with solar panels and native plantings.
